Identifying John is a 15 year old Caucasian male brought in by his parents for Information:

several OCD symptoms, primarily "wiping off" compulsions triggered

by seeing certain types of people.

Relevant History: Session 2. John and his mother attended session. Began with

> homework review. John brought in a fear hierarchy, which was further fleshed out and clarified in session. We then performed two exposures in session related to seeing photos of handicapped or MR people. Initially high SUDs (65-70) came down to 10-20 within 8 minutes to

first exposure, with quicker decreases on next two exposures.

Medications: None

Examination: John was noticeably anxious during exposure, but did well and did not

do any compulsions. He was open when discussing symptoms and did

not appear to be hiding any covert compulsions.

Assessment: John is struggling with moderate OCD symptoms, but is an excellent

candidate for EX/RP.

Diagnosis: OCD (300.3)

Treatment Plan: Parents were to help John complete one hour's worth of exposures to

photos of obese, acne, and handicapped stimuli. Next session will

continue EX/RP for OCD protocol.
